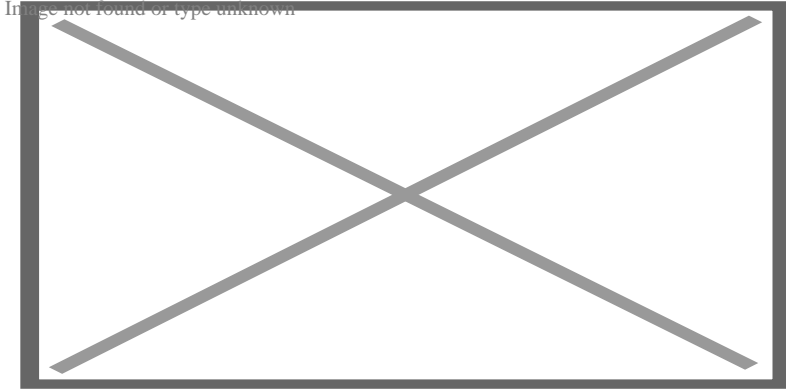


Source: Program No. 3: The first lecture in John Cage's class on "Music in Dialogue"
