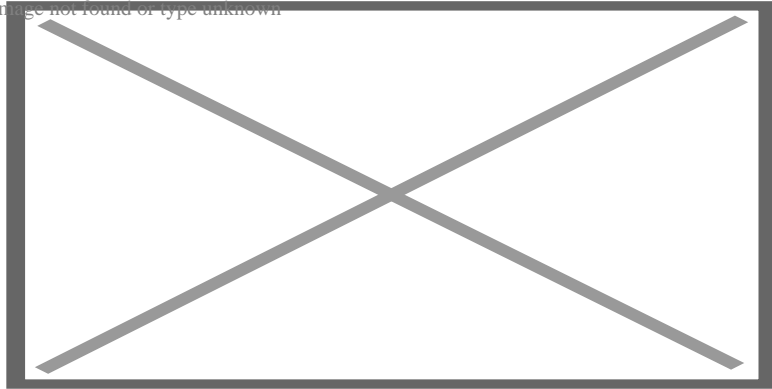


World Ear Project: Paul Matzner, October 27, 1986
